





## **MEMBER NOTICE:**

The continued spike in the Covid-19 infection rate throughout the island is a concern for all businesses and our community. For the protection of all, the Guam Chamber of Commerce, the Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce, and the Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association strongly urge establishments, *across all business sectors*, to take the necessary precautions recommended by Guam's medical professionals to keep customers and the community safe. Recent reports have shown an alarming increase in positive cases in the hundreds with the number of vaccinated and unvaccinated people testing positive for the COVID-19 virus, therefore please consider the following:

- Reduce occupancy levels to ensure social distancing is maintained to keep the customers safe (e.g. 50 percent for all businesses);
- Maintain health and safety protocols:
  - Watch your distance with six feet social distancing requirements;
  - Wear your mask (unless actively eating or drinking);
  - Wash your hands and/or sanitize;
  - o Proper contact tracing documentation;
- Encourage employees and customers to be vaccinated.
