ANALYSIS: The month of April reflected a -4% change in the number of room nights available for sale and increased 1% in the number of room nights sold compared to the same period last year, 2013. The Weighted Average Occupancy Rate reflects a 3 points change of 72%. The Weighted Average Room Rate inceased 5% at \$136. Preliminary arrival numbers from the Guam Visitors Bureau showed a 8% increase in total arrivals for the month of April. JGTA reflected a decrease of -6% while the Korea market increased by 55% and the Taiwan market reflects a increase of 5% compared to 2013. The mainland China market reflects a 18% increase and the Russia market reflects a 236% increase for the month of April 2014 as compared to the same period 2013.

Weighted Average Occupancy = Sum of Room Nights Sold divided by total number of Room Nights Available for sale by reporting hotels. **Weighted Average Room Rate** = Sum of all Room Sales divided by sum of all Room Nights Sold by Reporting Hotels.

Room Employee Ratio = (Hotel Rooms/Total Number of Employees from Reporting Hotels).
