ANALYSIS: The month of January reflected -7% decrease in the number of room nights available for sale and increased 8% in the number of room nights sold compared to the same period last year, 2011. The Weighted Average Occupancy Rate increased 11 points to 86%. The Weighted Average Room Rate also inceased 11% at \$131. Preliminary arrival numbers from the Guam Visitors Bureau showed a 6% increase in total arrivals for the month of January. JGTA reflected a 1% decrease while the Korea market increased by 13% and the Taiwan market shows a 105% increase compared to 2011. The mainland China market reflects a 278% increase and the Russia market reflects a 93% increase for the month of January 2012 as compared to the same period 2011.

Weighted Average Occupancy = Sum of Room Nights Sold divided by total number of Room Nights Available for sale by reporting hotels.

Weighted Average Room Rate = Sum of all Room Sales divided by sum of all Room Nights Sold by Reporting Hotels.

Room Employee Ratio = (Hotel Rooms/Total Number of Employees from Reporting Hotels).
