ANALYSIS: The month of July reflected a -6% decrease in the number of room nights available for sale and -1% in the number of room nights sold compared to the same period last year, 2006. The Weighted Average Occupancy Rate increased 8 pts. at 69%. The Weighted Average Room Rate increased 7% at \$111.00. Preliminary arrival numbers from the Guam Visitors Bureau reported a 1% increase in total arrivals, with JGTA showing -4% decrease, Korea showing a 12% increase, and Taiwan with a 107% increase for July 2007.

Weighted Average Occupancy = Sum of Room Nights Sold divided by total number of Room Nights Available for sale by reporting hotels.

Weighted Average Room Rate = Sum of all Room Sales divided by sum of all Room Nights Sold by Reporting Hotels.

Employee Room Ratio = (Total Hotel Rooms/Number of Employees from Reporting Hotels).
