ANALYSIS: The month of September reflected a 1% increase in the number of room nights available for sale and 11% in the number of room nights sold compared to the same period last year, 2006. The Weighted Average Occupancy Rate increased 14pts. at 64%. The Weighted Average Room Rate decreased 5% at \$100.00. Preliminary arrival numbers from the Guam Visitors Bureau reported a 5% increase in total arrivals, with JGTA showing 5% increase, Korea showing a 17% increase, and Taiwan with a 76% increase for September 2007.

Weighted Average Occupancy = Sum of Room Nights Sold divided by total number of Room Nights Available for sale by reporting hotels.

Weighted Average Room Rate = Sum of all Room Sales divided by sum of all Room Nights Sold by Reporting Hotels.

Employee Room Ratio = (Total Hotel Rooms/Number of Employees from Reporting Hotels).
