GHRA's training and certification courses are aimed to provide individuals with the skills needed to increase performance, improve service standards and provide job-specific skills for new and existing hospitality and service sector industry employees.

COURSE OVERVIEW:

As an authorized training provider with TiPS program from Minnesota, GHRA is a licensed trainer with the Department of Revenue & Taxation's ABC Compliance department to offer Responsible Alcohol Server/Seller Act (RASSA) training with TiPS certification. Employees responsible for serving or selling alcohol in off-premise or on-premise outlets are required to take a RASSA class with a certified trainer. The mandatory three (3) hour class with a one (1) hour exam is required by law. Should the participant pass the exam, GHRA will provide the information to the ABC Compliance Division for processing the ABC card, which is valid for three (3) years. GHRA has been a TiPS certified trainer for more than 30 years.
